Incident:

Possession of an Explosive Device

Date/Time: Monday, January 12, 2009, 3:54 P.M.

Location: 900 Block West Morton, Porterville

Suspect: Cruz Valles (28 years old)

Summary:

On Monday, January 12, 2009, at approximately 3:54 p.m. Officers responded to a local motel in Porterville regarding the discovery of a **possible explosive device**. The device was discovered during a motel room cleaning.

Cruz Valles had just been arrested from the same room a short time earlier and booked at the Tulare County Sheriff Department, Porterville Sub-Station, on other charges.

Mr. Cruz was re-contacted at the Sub-Station and admitted to possessing an explosive device in the room. Mr. Cruz denied making the device or intending to use it in a dangerous manner.

The Tulare County Bomb Squad was called out and safely diffused the device. The Bomb Squad confirmed it was a small explosive device commonly known as a "pipe bomb."

Mr. Cruz was already in custody on other charges and was charged with an additional crime of 12303.2 PC-Possession of an Explosive Device.
